All of the gifts and toys are printed onto ornaments and are located on the Christmas tree in the narthex. If you are willing to provide any of these items, please take the ornament off the tree and replace it with a regular ornament. ### **Gifts for the Shelter:**

Twin-sized sheets, blankets, bath towels, wash cloths, pillows, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, soap, lotions, new underwear, new socks, cleaning supplies, paper products, \$45.00 (covers the cost of a night stay at the shelter)

**Infants and Toddlers:** sleepers, clothing, mittens, hats, nightlights, etc.

**Children:** Clothing, underwear, socks

**Teenage Girls:** Clothing, underwear, socks, coats, pajamas, slippers

**Teenage Boys:** Clothing, underwear, socks, slippers

**Women:** Clothing, underwear, socks, slippers, pajamas, sweat suits, bath towels, kitchen sets, suitcases, small household items
